The **object of a sentence** is the person or thing that receives the action of the verb. It is the who or what that the subject does something to.

Eg. The black cat chased the little **mouse**. The mouse is the object, it is being chased.

The little mouse chased the black <u>cat.</u> The cat is the object, it is being chased.

He is running in the field. He is the subject, he is running.

So remember the subject does the verb action and the object receives the verb action

Some more examples:

- He (subject) plays (verb) football (object) skillfully.
- I (subject) will be going (verb) to the <u>shop</u> (object) tomorrow
